Bambi is a large bodied, deep and wide, cow with a nice udder. Her single heifer was exceptionally nice (and now lives in Oregon). The rest of her offspring have been males; one bull quality and the rest made fine fat steers. Bambi was halter trained when she was a heifer, but has not been worked with on the halter since. She has an easy going way about her. As you can see from her photo, she does have residual horn stubs as a result of a less than perfect dehorning. Shown with this year's steer - a big healthy guy - below, they are sold as a cow/calf pair until he is weaned in the fall. Bambi is currently exposed to Moosters Red Rover for a Spring 2021 calf (although Bambi is horned, Rover is homozygous polled, so the calf will be heterozygous polled -- and red and A2A2).
